## Household isolation Guidance

The decreasing infection rates, asymptomatic testing and vaccine rollout are hugely positive steps forward. However Covid-19 is still very much with us and as a result, we must continue to follow all guidance and legal requirements .

If any member of your household shows one or more symptoms of Covid-19, you must all isolate and the person with symptoms book a PCR test at a testing centre.

If anyone in your household is advised to isolate as they have been identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive, it is only that person that needs to isolate unless they go on to develop symptoms themselves.

A reminder that household lateral flow testing kits are not to be used where people have symptoms of Covid-19. Anyone with symptoms must seek a full PCR test.
