Dear Parents/Carers,

We have been in the routine of staggered start and departure times for a long time now. Please do not arrive earlier than the gate opening times and form queues outside the gates. We are getting increasing reports of our parents/children obstructing the footpaths. Some children are not being adequately supervised in the queues and this is leading to incidents of poor behaviour. Residents living near the side gate are also unhappy that children and parents are using their front gardens as areas to wait or run around on. Some residents have been sworn at by some of our parents when they have asked them to move. Please be considerate to our neighbours. Taking advantage of the staggered times means that there is more opportunities for parking, no need to queue and it is easier to socially distance. If you need to bring your child to school earlier, you are welcome to take advantage of our breakfast club provision to ensure you can drop-off your child and get to work in time.

There is also a considerable amount of litter being dropped around the schools site. Our trusty eco-warriors Cai and Callum are doing an excellent job of trying to keep our school areas tidy. Please make sure that you are helping them in their quest for a litter-free school.
